## Up skilling of Hindi Teachers :



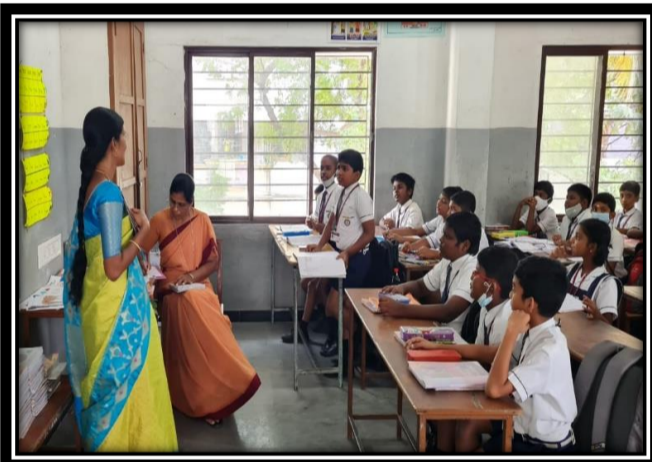
